A lightning strike can happen in half a second and can heat the surrounding air to over 50,000 degrees fahrenheit.

Steps you can take to protect you and your home....



- *Stay off the phone Phone use is the leading cause of indoor lightning injuries.
- *Stay away from any sources of water sinks, showers, bathtubs, pools lightning can travel through plumbing.
- *Avoid using washers and dryers.
- *Stay away from doors and windows.
- *Stay off computers and other electrical devices (anything that puts you in direct contact with electricity).
- *Unplug any appliances that are not in use. Use surge protectors but do not rely on them.
- *Do not go outside for 30 minutes after the last thunder is heard lightning can strike from 10 miles away.
